

HYGIENE GUIDELINES

for cultural face-to-face courses of the cultural office

valid from October 11, 2021

The following organizational information and hygiene measures must be observed for participation in face-to-face offers based on the „Niedersächsische Verordnung über infektionspräventive Schutzmaßnahmen gegen das Coronavirus SARS-CoV-2 und dessen Varianten (Niedersächsische Corona-Verordnung)“ of August 24, 2021.

2G rule

In principle, until further notice, only people who have been fully vaccinated against the SARS-Cov-2 virus (proof of vaccination) or who have recovered from an infection (proof of recovery, max. 6 months old) are allowed to stay in the premises of the Studentenwerk Göttingen. All evidence is only valid in connection with an official photo ID. In the case of presence offers by the cultural office, the course instructors are responsible for compliance with the 2G rule.

Exclusion from participation in the course

Course participants who cannot provide proof of vaccination or recovery, or who have unexplained symptoms that could be related to SARS-CoV-2 (e.g. respiratory disease, fever, loss of taste / smell) are not allowed to take part in the courses. The course instructors are entitled to exclude these people from participating in the course.

Contact details

Contact data will be collected from all course participants in accordance with Section 6 of the Lower Saxony Corona Ordinance of August 24, 2021. The family name, first name, full address and telephone number as well as the date and time must be documented.

These data are stored for 3 weeks and destroyed after the retention period has expired (at the latest after 4 weeks). In the event of illness, the data will only be forwarded to the responsible health department. The respective course instructors are responsible.

Personal hygiene

All course instructors and course participants are required to adhere to the general hygiene instructions in times of the SARS-CoV-2 pandemic (regular hand washing, hand disinfection, sneeze and cough labels).

Ventilation

Doors and windows should be kept open as long as possible to exchange the indoor air. After one hour at the latest, adequate ventilation (intermittent ventilation / cross ventilation) must be provided.

Cleaning

The course room is cleaned every morning by a cleaner. Doorknobs, door handles, handrails and light switches are cleaned and disinfected daily.
