

Important information on entering Germany/Göttingen

Entry

1. There is currently an obligation to test people entering the country from a [risk area](#) classified by the RKI. Please check whether you are entering from a risk area
2. A corona test must be done within 72 hours of entry, if necessary directly at the airport or later with a general practitioner. Alternatively, a molecular biological test (PCR test) must have been carried out within 48 hours before entry in a state of the European Union or a state listed on the RKI [website](#):
3. You must remain in quarantine until a negative test result is obtained.
4. Please make an [appointment](#) as early as possible with the residents' registration office to register:
5. The following information must be submitted to the Göttingen Health Office (gesundheitsamt@goettingen.de) when entering from a risk area, so that a decision can be made on whether quarantine should be imposed:
 - a. First and last name
 - b. Gender
 - c. Date of birth
 - d. Country from which you entered
 - e. Telephone and e-mail address
 - f. Address in Göttingen

Required information to the dormitory administration / service office

1. Date and time of entry into Göttingen.
2. Information as to whether you are entering from a [risk area](#). Please check currently which countries are classified as [risk areas](#) by the Robert Koch Institute:
3. Duration of any quarantine that may have been ordered.
4. Contact the relevant dormitory administration/ service office only after your quarantine period has expired, in order to clarify further formalities, as it is forbidden to leave the dormitory during the quarantine period.

Please observe the general rules of conduct:

1. Compliance with the hygiene measures in the dormitories.
2. It is obligatory to wear a mouth-nose cover in the common rooms "kitchen, bathroom, lounge".
3. Keep a distance of 1.5 m from other flatmates.
4. Avoid shaking hands, hugs and any physical contact.
5. In case of quarantine, it is obligatory to wear a mouth and nose cover in all common rooms. The common rooms may only be entered individually and stays must be kept to a minimum. Please inform your flat mates about any quarantine and its duration by posting a notice on the door of the room.

Picking up the keys

1. Please understand that the keys will be handed over primarily via the university's Buddy Service. It is imperative for the organisation to [register](#) as soon as possible.
2. If the Exchange-Buddy-Service is not used, a prior appointment with the dormitory administration / service office is required. This is only possible in exceptional cases.
3. The collection of the key from the dormitory administration / service office is only possible via the existing key safes, provided that sufficient capacity is available.
